The **Canadian Centre for Child Protection's (C3P)** *Billy Brings his Buddies* program is a **Kids in the Know**[®] initiative. The *Billy Brings his Buddies* program helps caregivers teach children the valuable lesson of always having another individual – a buddy – accompany them when they are going places or going online, whether it be walking to and from school, going to the store, or playing online games. Through various activities, children learn that a buddy could be a mom, dad, grandma, grandpa, older sister, older brother, or babysitter. When children learn and adopt this very important habit, they can reduce their vulnerability to victimization and increase their personal safety.

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




DRAW A SAFE BUDDY FOR BILLY

he always brings a buddy along.




BUDDY MATCHING GAME

Match Basmah with a safe buddy who takes care of her. Draw a line to all the characters that are a safe buddy.













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Look at the picture above. If the buddy system is being used correctly, colour the smiley face. If the buddy system is not being used correctly, colour the sad face.








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
HELP BILLY AND BASMAH GET TO THE PARK


Help Billy and Basmah get to the park safely. Draw a line through the maze to show them the way!

Colour the pieces of Billy and Basmah on the next page. Cut out the pieces and glue them in the spaces they fit below.






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ANSWER KEY

- **Page 2:** A safe buddy for Billy should be someone who can take care of and supervise him (someone 12 years and up), such as: mom, dad, grandma, grandpa, older sister, older brother, babysitter, etc.
- **Page 3:** All characters should have lines drawn to them except the cat.
- **Page 4:** The following characters should be coloured red: the friend and the dog. All other characters should be coloured green.
- **Page 5:** The sad face should be coloured. Billy is at the park by himself and is not practicing the buddy system.
- Page 6: buddy / play
- Page 7: come / safe
- Page 8: She / six





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
